FIFTH ORGANIZATIONAL SESSION

JOURNAL

Monday, May 23, 1977

CALL TO ORDER: At 1:20 p.m., delegate Carl T. C. Gutierrez, president of the First Constitutional Convention, called the Fifth Organizational Session of the Convention to order.

PRAYER: Delegate Thomas Crisostomo of Talofofo gave the day's prayer.
